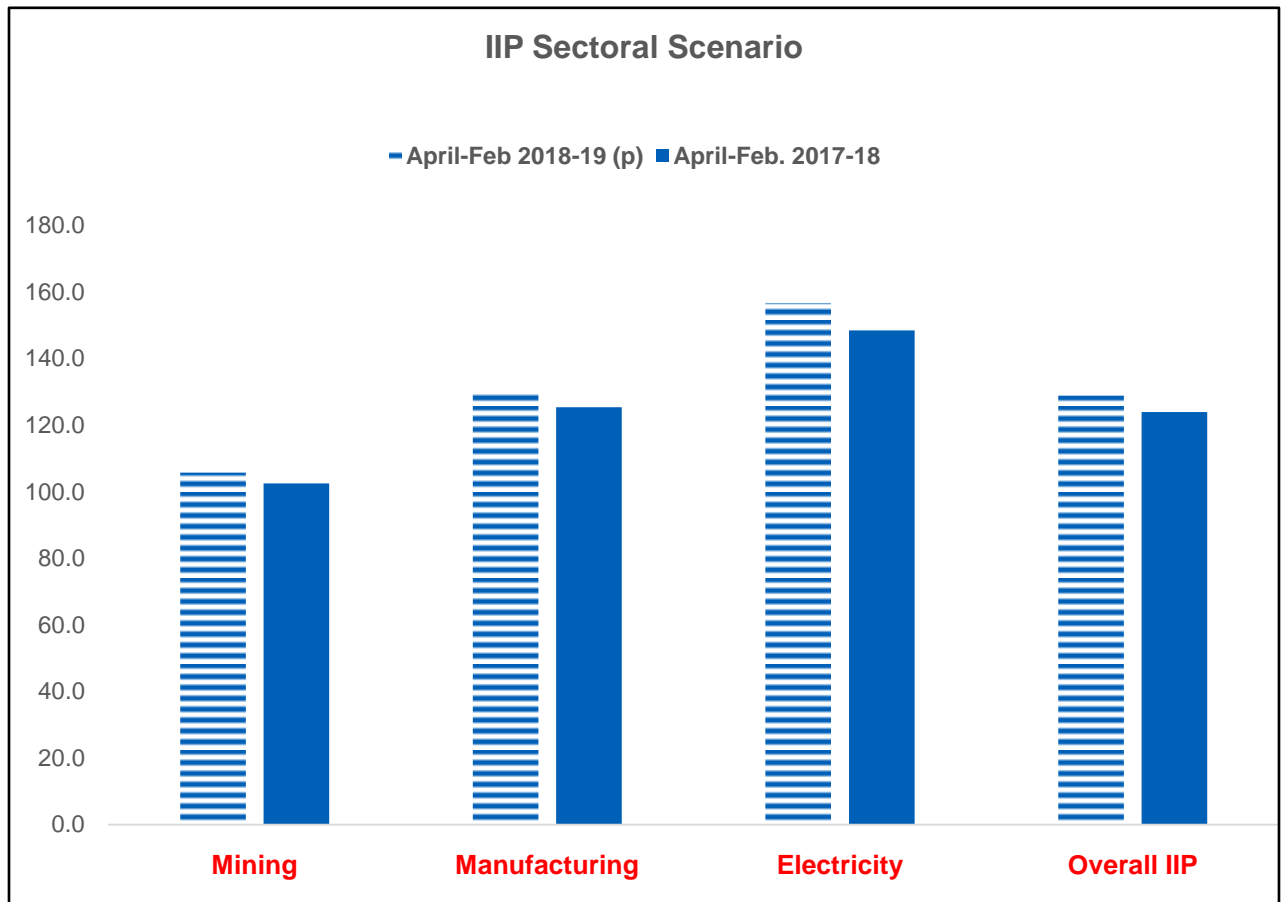

Indian Economy Highlights

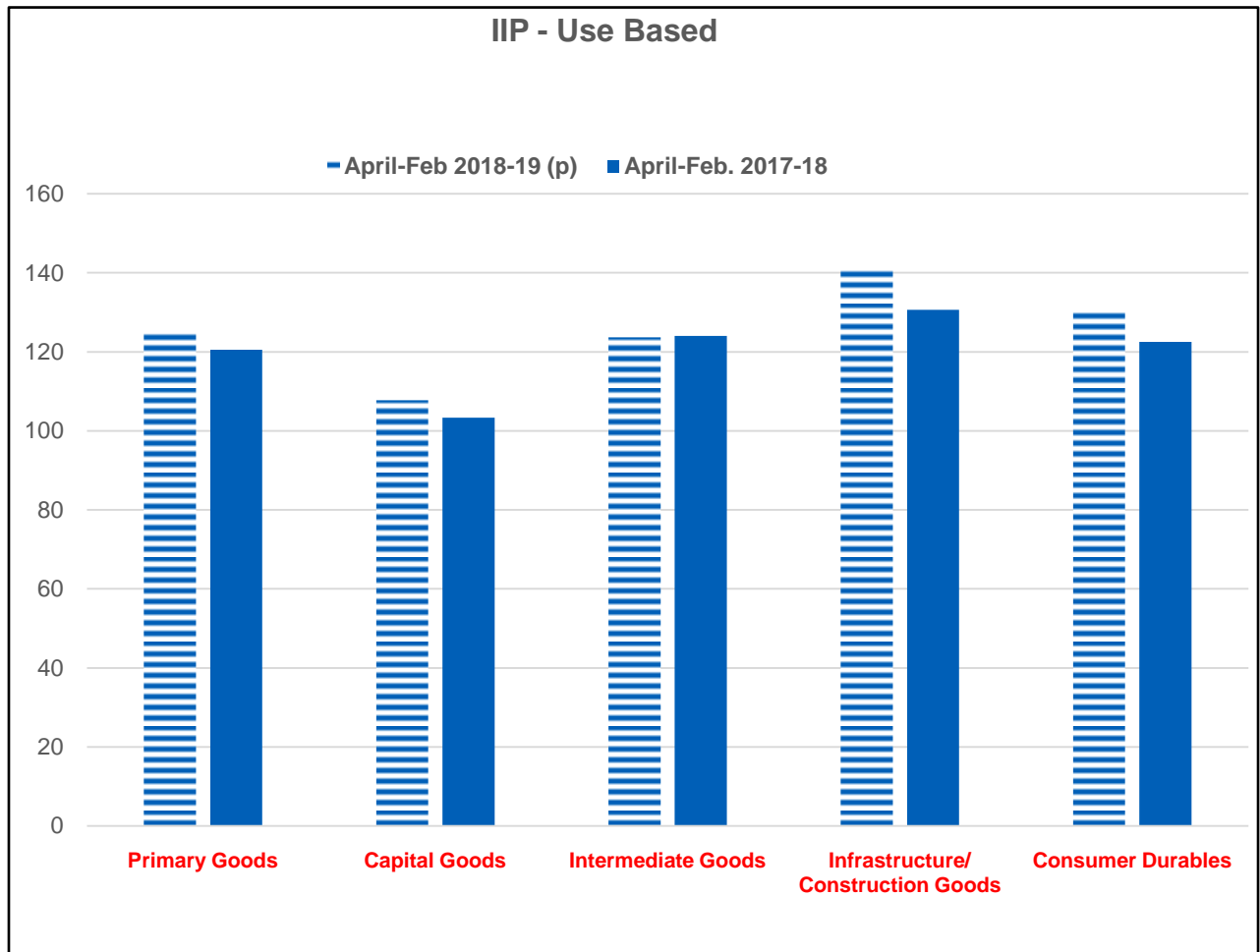

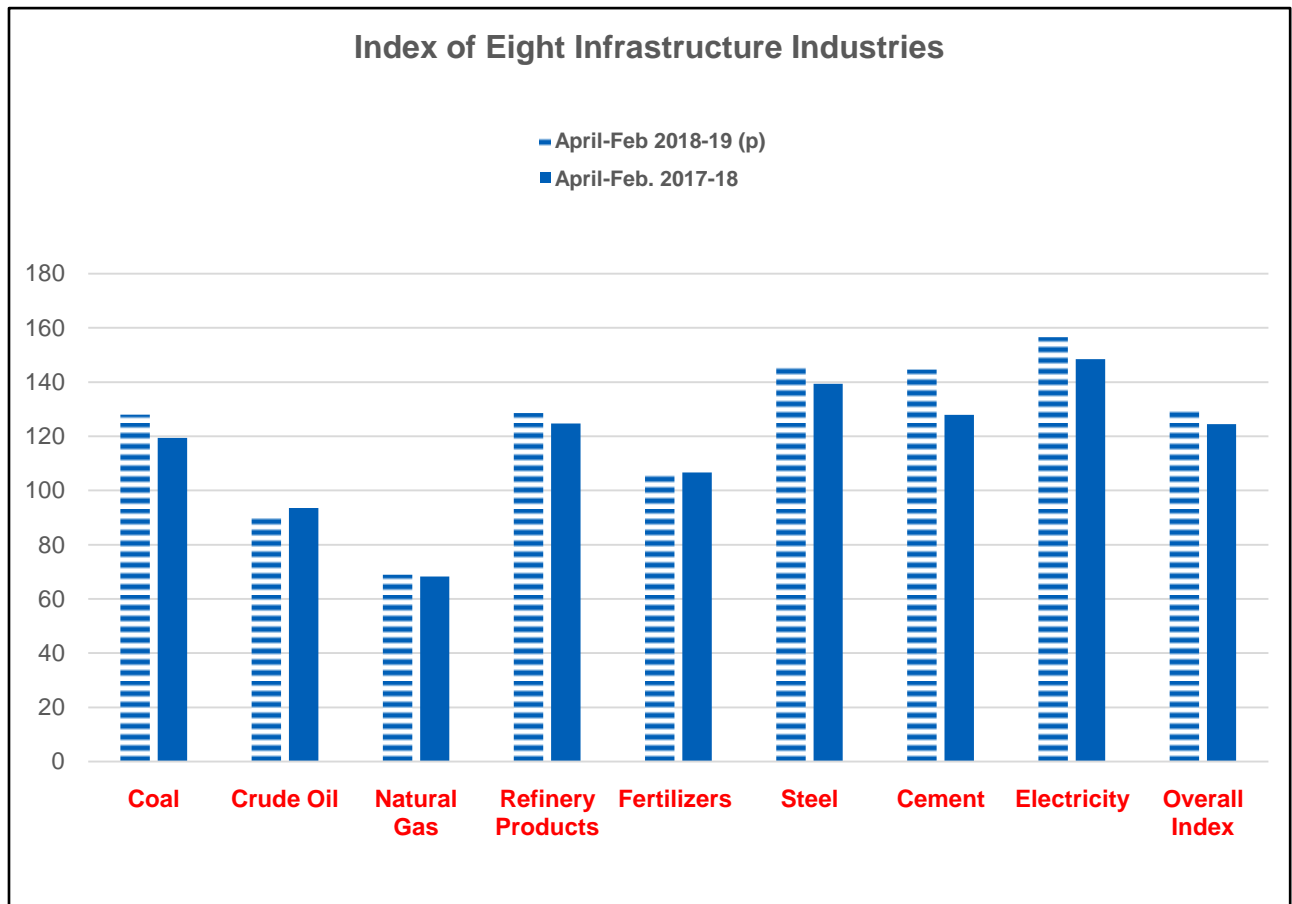


The Use-Based scenario of the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during April –February 2018-19 (prov.) show that excepting a minor decline in Intermediate Goods, all the other sectors recorded a growth with Infrastructure / Construction Goods (7.7 %)reporting the highest and Primary Goods, the lowest (3.6 %).

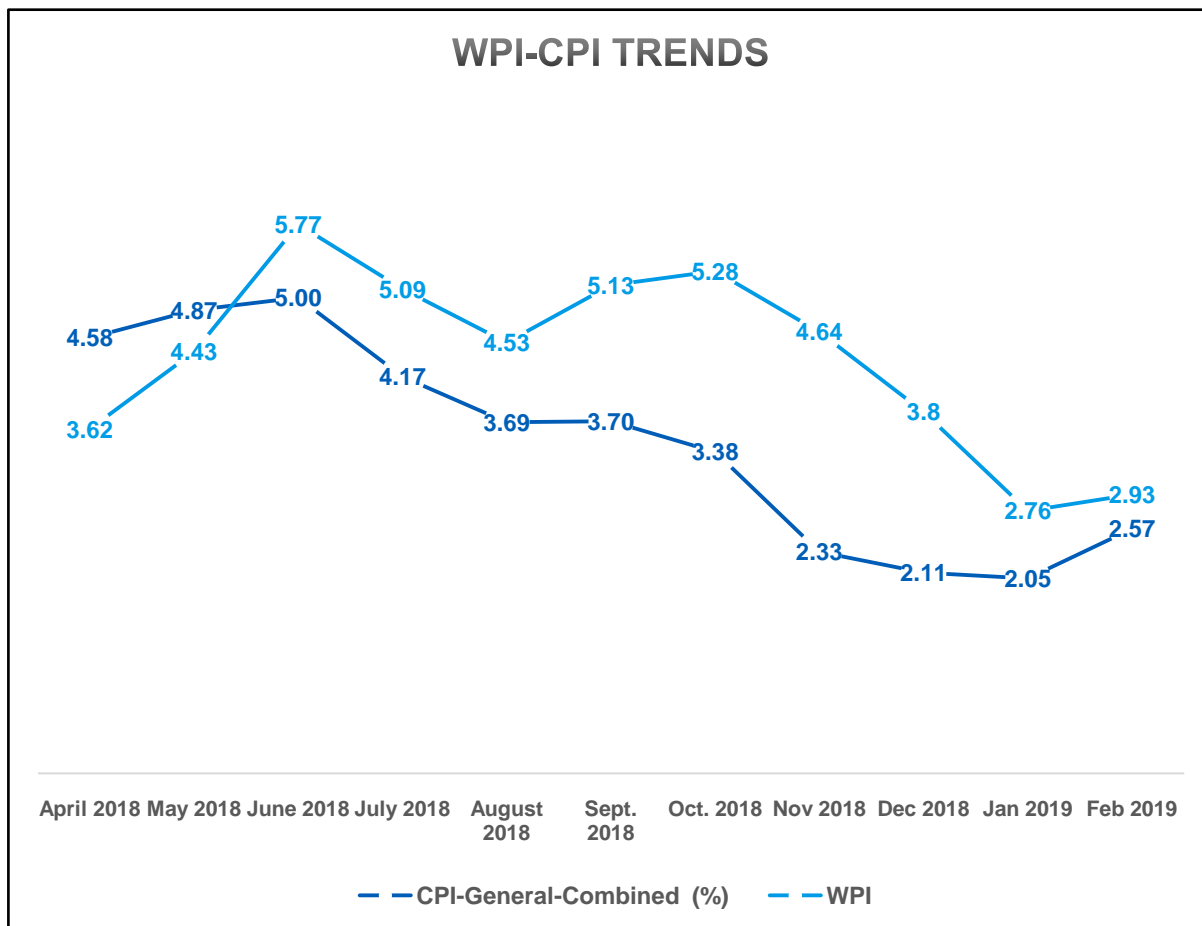


The growth rate of the Eight Core Infrastructure Industries was up by 4.3 % during April – February 2018-19 (prov.), encouraged by growth in most sectors, specially Coal (7.1 %) and Cement (13 %), Electricity (5.4 %) but pulled down by decline in growth rates in case of Crude Oil (4 %) and Fertilizers (0.02 %).

Performance of Indian Iron & Steel Industry in 2018 – 19 : Summary

Highlights

The following is a status report on the performance of Indian steel industry during April – March 2018-19, based on provisional data released by Joint Plant Committee (JPC) in its MIS Report, March 2019. It is to be noted that total finished steel includes both non-alloy and alloy (including stainless steel) and all comparisons are made with regard to same period of last year.

Major highlights

- Production of crude steel was at 106.56 million tonnes (mt), a growth of 3.3%.
- At 138 mt, crude steel capacity indicated an utilisation of 77% compared to 75% of last year.
- Hot metal production was 72.63mt, an increase of 6.8%.
- Pig iron production was 6.06mt, up by 5.7%.



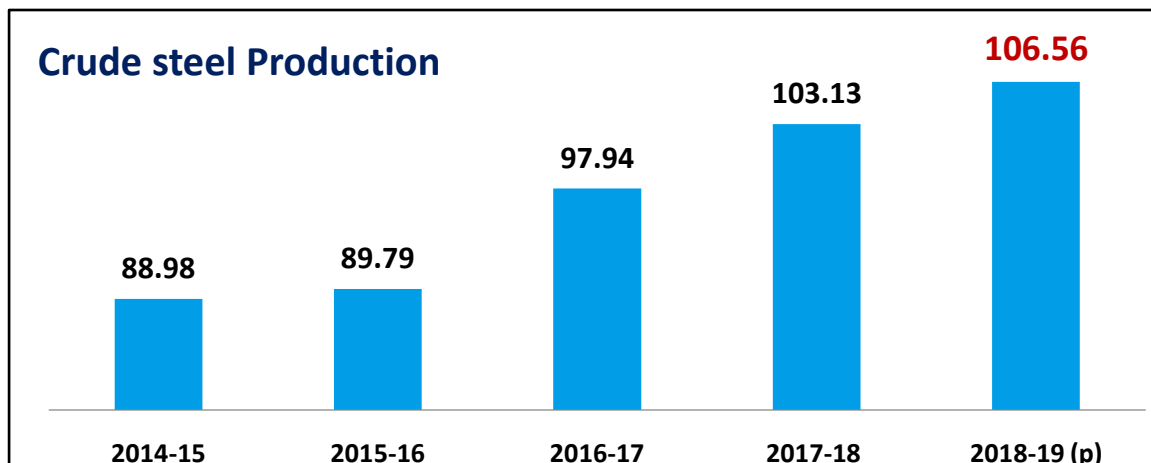

- Sponge iron production was 33.04mt, up by 8.3%.
- Total finished steel gross production was 131.57mt, an increase of 3.7%.
- Export of total finished steel reached 6.36mt, a decrease of 33.9%.
- Import of total finished steel was 7.83mt, an increase of 4.7%.
- India was a net importer of total finished steel.
- Consumption of total finished steel was 97.54mt, an increase of 7.5%.



Crude Steel

a. Overall Trends



- At 106.56 million tonnes (mt) in 2018-19, India's crude steel production grew by 3.3% over 2017-18 and by 5.5% on a CAGR basis during the last five years ending 2018-19. Given the above production for 2018-19 and with capacity at 138 mt, crude steel capacity utilization stood at 77% during 2018-19 compared to 75% of last year.

b. Trends in shares of Public / Private Sectors

- With 80% share, the Private Sector (85.07mt, up by 2%) led crude steel production in 2018-19.

- In fact, India's crude steel production has been consistently led by the Private Sector in the last five years ending 2018-19, with average share of the Sector standing 81% during this period.

c. Trends in Other Producers vis-à-vis SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar Steel, JSWL, JSPL

- With a 60% share, SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar Steel, JSWL, JSPL together produced 63.60mt(up by 7.1%) of crude steel in 2018-19 while the rest 40% was the share of the Other Producers (decline of 1.8%) during this period.
- In fact, the trend of last five years ending 2018-19 indicate that India's crude steel production has been driven by these six producers together whose average share during this period stood at 56%.

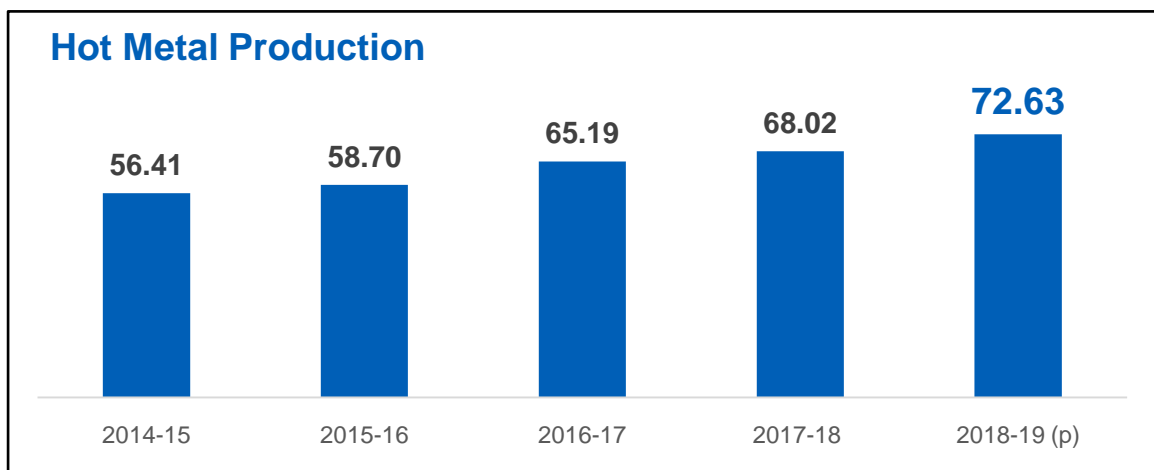

Hot Metal

- At 72.63mt in 2018-19, domestic hot metal production grew by 6.8% over 2017-18 and grew by 6.7% on a CAGR basis during the last five years ending 2018-19.
- With 68% share, the Private Sector (49.35mt, up by 5.2%) led hot metal production in 2018-19, with the average share of the Sector also at 68% in the last five years ending 2018-19.



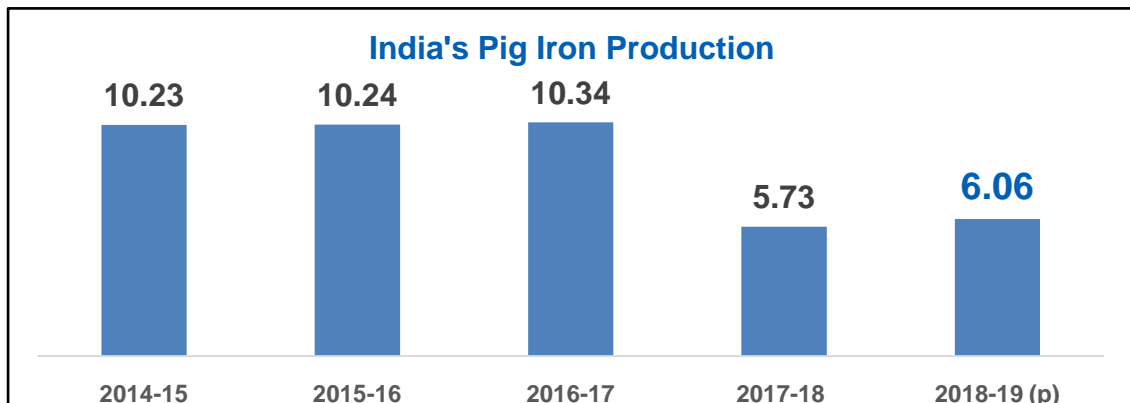
Pig Iron

- At 6.06mt in 2018-19, India's pig iron production grew by 5.7% over 2017-18 but recorded a decline of 6.2% on a CAGR basis during the last five years ending 2018-19.
- With 90% share, the Private Sector (5.5mt, up by 2%) led pig iron production in 2018-19, with the average share of the Sector at 93% in the last five years ending 2018-19.
- With a 84% share, the Other Producers (5.09mt, up by 1.8%) led pig iron production in 2018-19 while the rest 16% was the share of the SAIL, RINL, TSL,



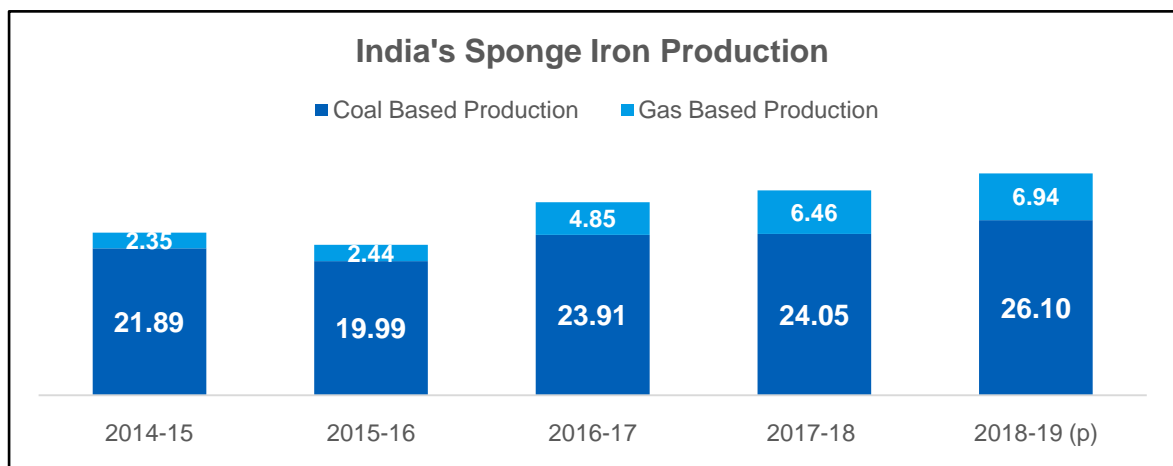

Essar Steel, JSWL, JSPL taken together. In fact, the trend of last five years ending 2018-19 has been similar in this regard.



Sponge Iron

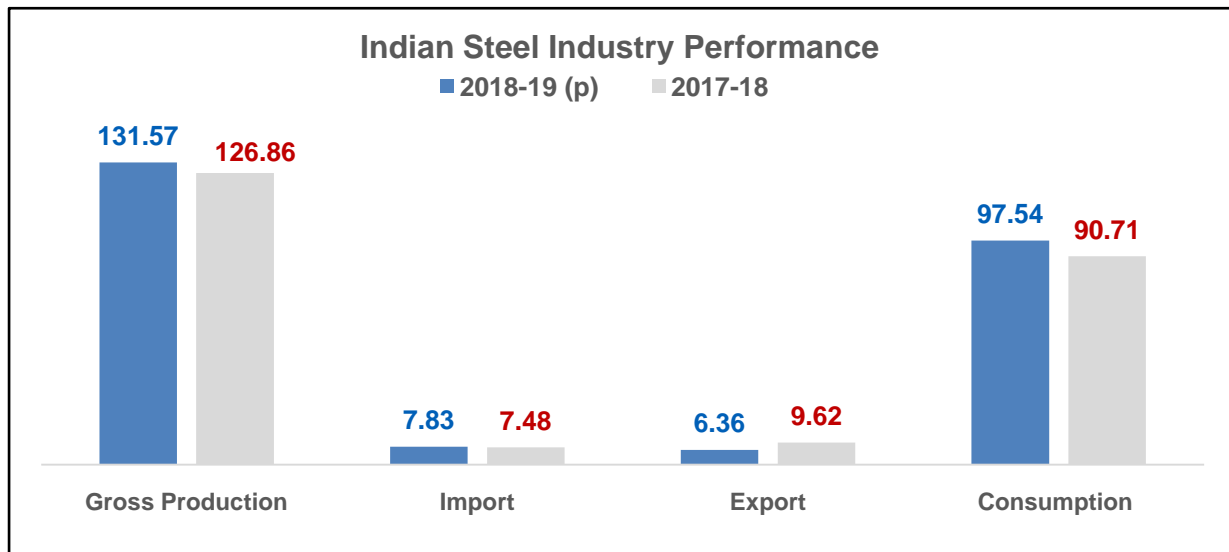
- At 33.04mt in 2018-19, India's sponge iron production grew by 8.3% over 2017-18 and grew by 7.6% on a CAGR basis during the last five years ending 2018-19.
- With 79% share, the coal based route (26.1mt, up by 8.5%) led sponge iron production in 2018-19, with the average share of the Sector at 84% in the last five years ending 2018-19.





Total Finished Steel

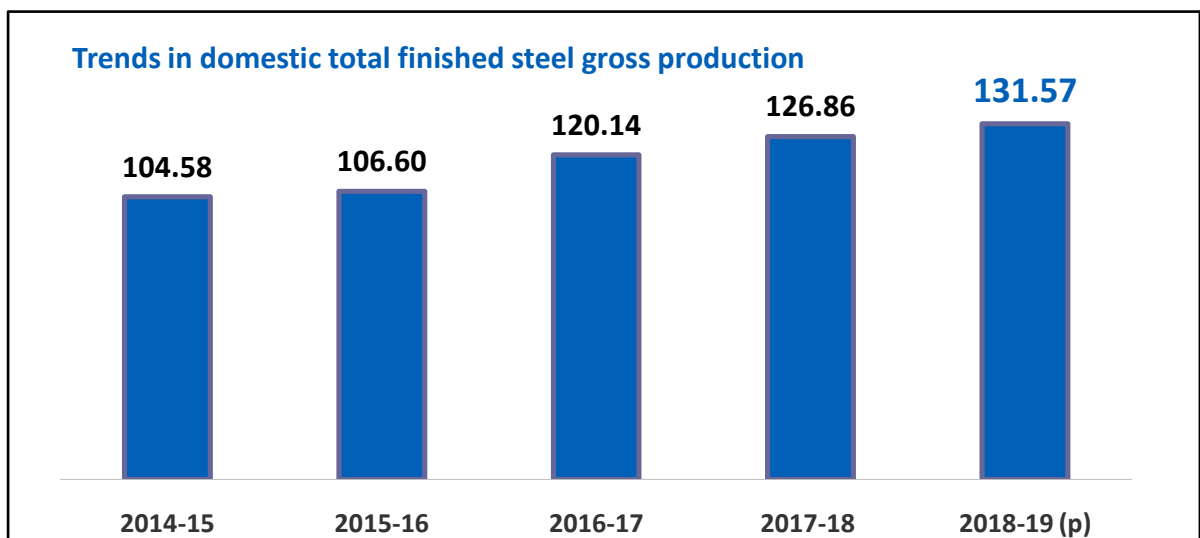
A. Total Finished Steel - OVERALL

a. Overall Trends

- At 131.57mt in 2018-19, gross production of total finished steel grew by 3.7% over 2017-18 and was up by 5.8% on a CAGR basis during the last five years ending 2018-19.

- With 86% share, the Private Sector (113mt, up by 3.8%) led gross production of total finished steel in 2018-19. In fact, India's gross production of finished steel has been consistently led by the Private Sector in the last five years, ending 2018-19, with average share of the Sector standing 86%.

- With a 56% share, SAIL, RINL, TSL, Essar Steel, JSWL, JSPL taken together produced 73.42 mt (up by 6.2%) of finished steel in 2018-19 while the rest 44% was the share of the Other Producers (growth of 0.8%) during this period. In fact, the trend of last five years ending 2018-19 indicate that India's gross production of total finished steel has been driven by these six producers together whose average share during this period stood at 52%.

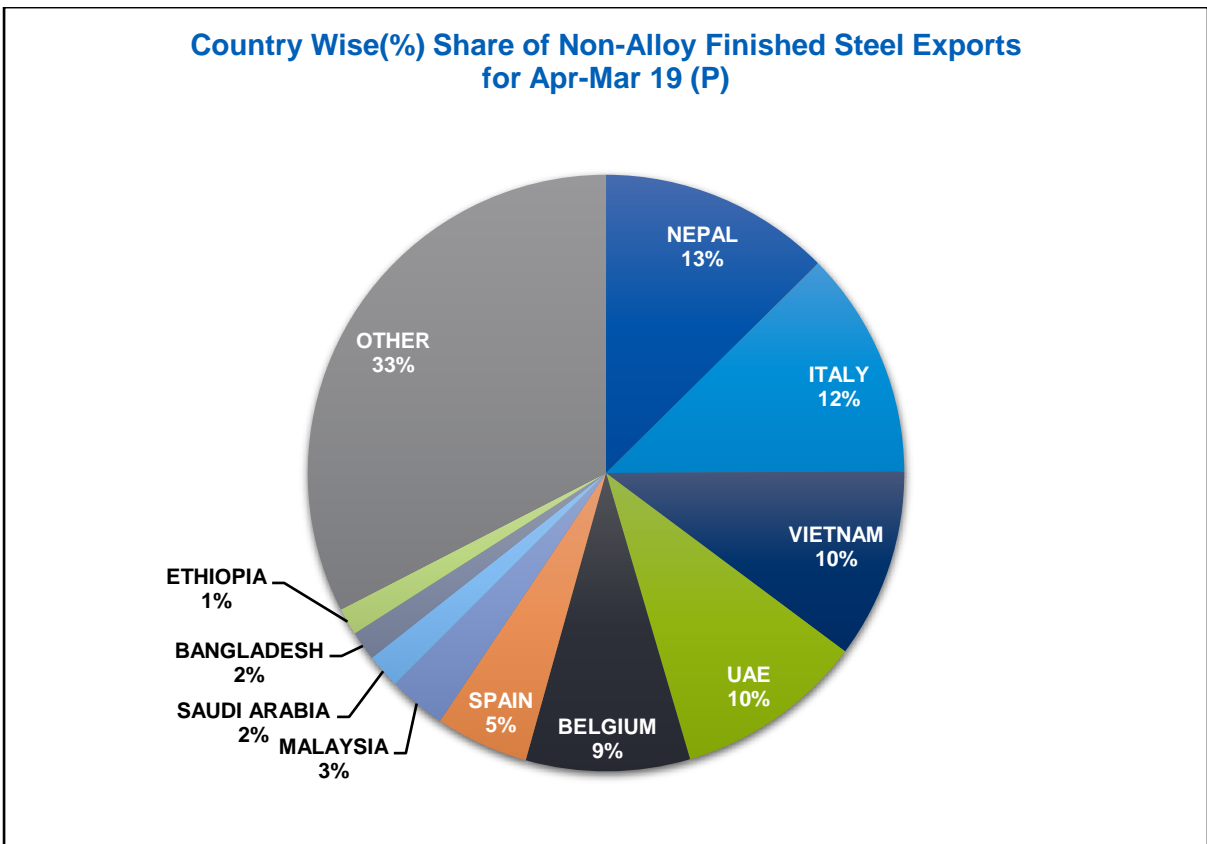
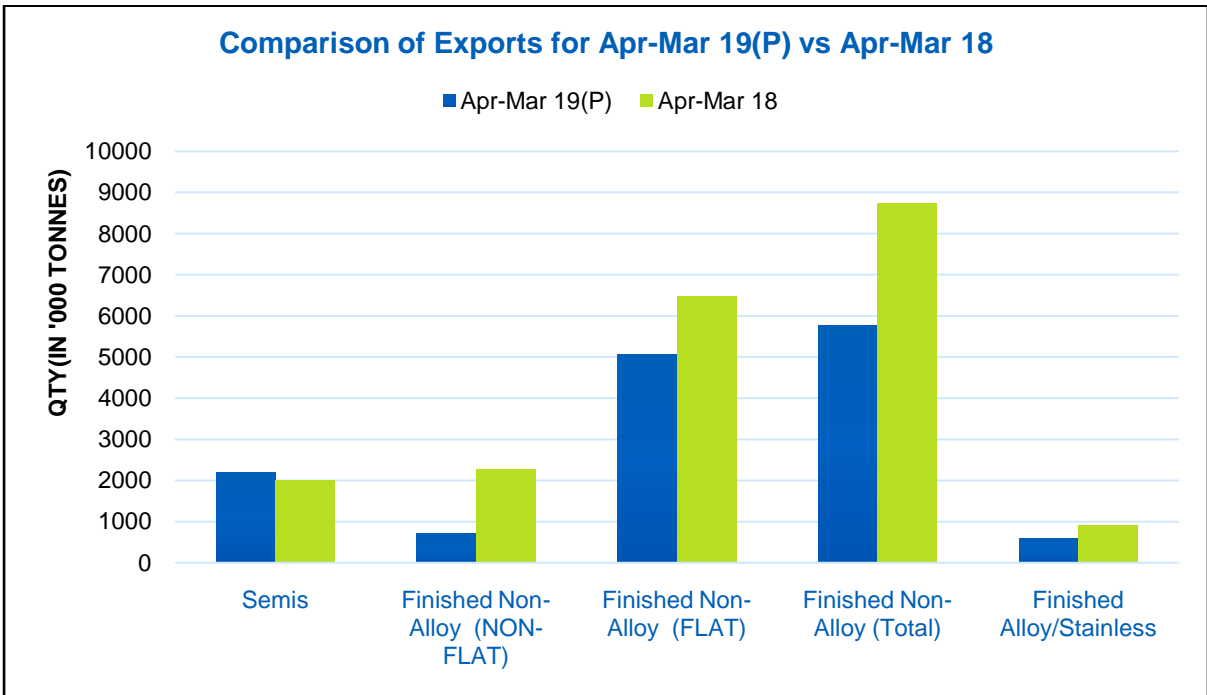
C. Total Finished Steel – IMPORT & EXPORT

- Total finished steel exports stood at 6.36 mt in 2018-19 and declined by 33.9% over 2017-18 while imports stood at 7.83mt and increased by 4.7% in 2018-19 over 2017-18.
- Such trends implied that India emerged as a net importer of total finished steel in 2018-19 in contrast to its net exporter status of 2017-18.
- For the last five year period ending 2018-19, on a CAGR basis, exports grew by 1.2% while imports grew by 7.5%.
- Korean imports (2.94 mt) had the largest share (37%) in major flat items, making it the largest import market for India during this period. China (imports down by 19%) was the 2nd largest import market, with its share in overall total falling from 26% in 2017-18 to 20% in 2018-19.
- Import of total finished steel valued at Rs. 49317 crore in 2018-19.
- Nepal (13% share) was the largest export market for India during this period.
- Exports of total finished steel valued at Rs. 33153 crore in 2018-19.



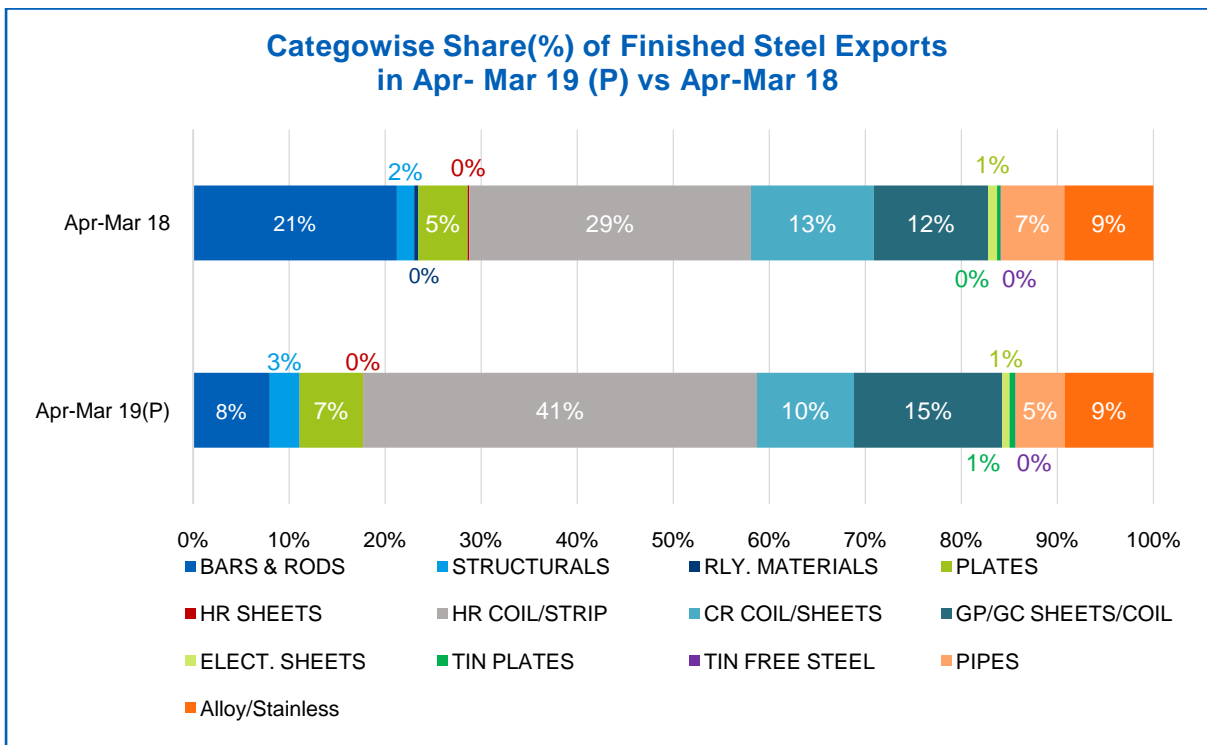
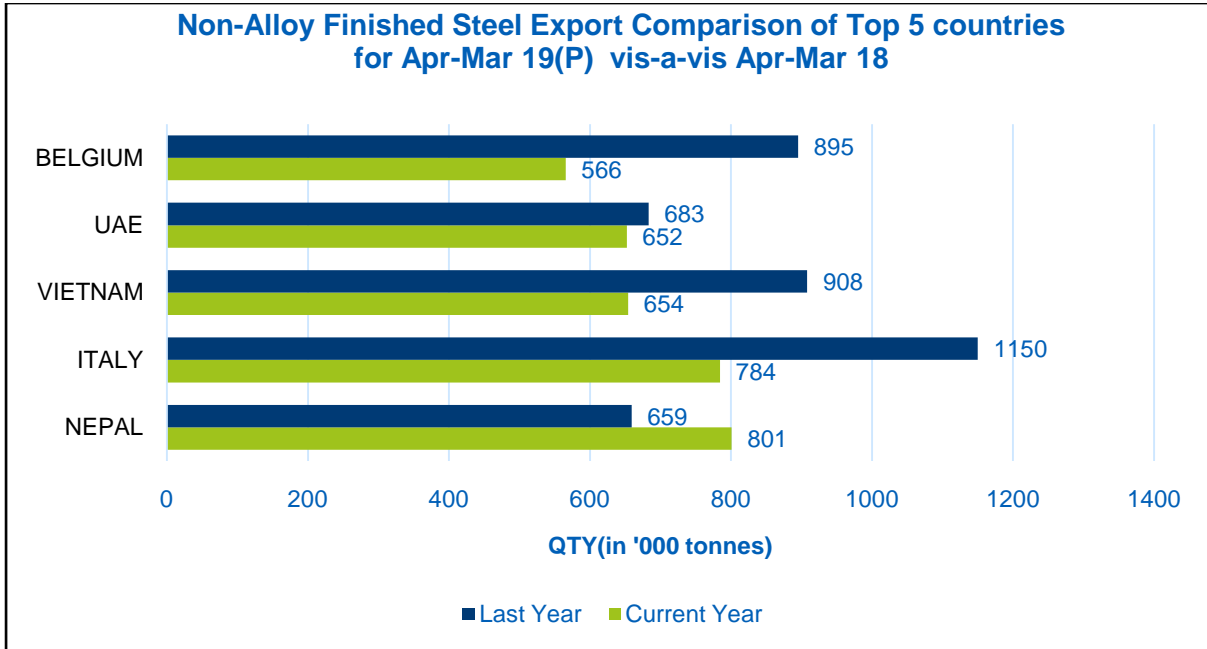

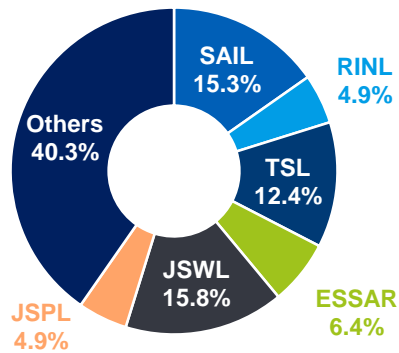

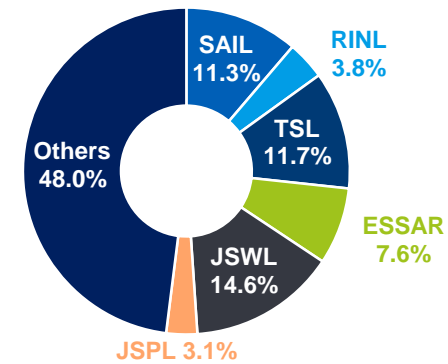
PRODUCERWISE SHARE OF PRODUCTION FOR SALE

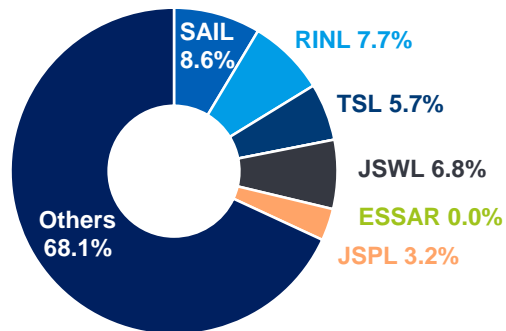
Crude Steel Production



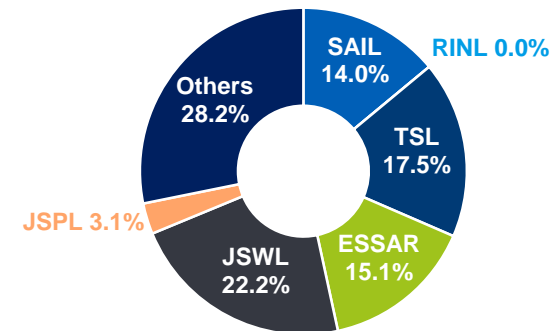
Finished Steel for Sale (Non-Alloy & Alloy)
